If parents wish to take their children home following the events. Parents can take children from 13.00. Staff will remain in school for any children that are unable to be collected.

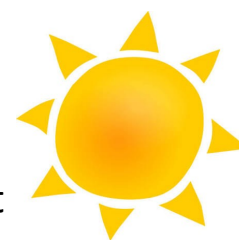
Cricket
